THE CHARLES JOHN EVERARD SCHOLARSHIP

RULES

Whereas the late Mrs Ella Syme Everard has devised and bequeathed the residue of her estate (amounting to approximately \$260,000) to the University for the purpose of founding, in memory of her late husband Charles John Everard, one or more scholarships for original research in such branches of agricultural or horticultural science as many from time to time be determined by the Council of the University, the following rules are hereby made:

1. There shall be scholarships to be known as "Charles John Everard Scholarships"
2. The purpose of the scholarships is to enable graduates studying at the University of Adelaide to undertake original research in any branch of the agricultural or horticultural sciences.
3. A scholarship may be offered to an applicant whose proposed research is approved by the Head of his/her Department and is substantially connected with a branch of the agricultural or horticultural sciences. Scholarships will therefore not be limited to applicants whose proposed research will be conducted within the Faculty of Agricultural and Natural Resource Science.
4. A scholarship will be awarded for postgraduate research, and shall be tenable at the University of Adelaide.
5. The CJ Everard Scholarship shall be advertised in the University of Adelaide Adelaidean and shall be awarded on the basis of academic merit and research potential.
6. Scholarships shall be tenable for one year and may, if the scholarship holder shows satisfactory progress, be renewed for a second consecutive year. A scholarship may be renewed for a third consecutive year under the same conditions for studies towards a PhD degree, and may be extended up to an additional six months in special circumstances.
7. The amount of a postgraduate scholarship will be an amount ten per cent greater than the amount of a University of Adelaide Scholarship for Postgraduate Research current at the time of application.
8. Where more than one scholarship is made in any year, the scholarships shall be known as the Charles John Everard No. 1 Scholarship, and the Charles John Everard No. 2 Scholarship, or as the case may be.
9. The offer of a CJ Everard Scholarship shall be made by the Council on the recommendation of the Board of Graduate Studies.
10. An application for extension of tenure of a scholarship must be made in writing to the Scholarships Officer and should include a report on the scholarship holder's work during the preceding year, together with a recommendation from the Head of the Department in which he/she is working.
