“WATER IN ADELAIDE: understanding the *crisis*”

Adelaide, in common with all other major population centres south of the Tropics, is subject to water restrictions which are set to continue until substantial rains occur in our local catchments and in those of the Murray-Darling Basin. We are informed that we are experiencing “...the worst drought since records have been kept...” or that it is, perhaps, the “once in 1,000 years drought” that has spelt the doom of the River Murray lower lakes. Then there is El Nino and climate change to contend with
